Definitions

Settlor: Anyone who has contributed cash, property, assets to the trust at any time during the trusts life.

Trustee(s): an individual(s) or trust institution that holds legal title to property in trust for the benefit of the trust beneficiaries.

Beneficiary: includes the person(s) for whose benefit the trust is created, therefore the person(s) who has beneficial ownership.

** CRA Trust Number: How to Apply for one

You can apply for a trust account number with the CRA through your MyAccount. It will display your trust number after having completed the application process and that can be used to file the trust return.

We will also need to submit documentation that proves the bare trust arrangement exists. Depending on the bare trust arrangement applicable to you, the documents needed could vary. Please contact us to determine what additional documentation you should provide us.
